

## SPECIAL FLOOR PLAN NOTES

Please utilize these notes to help you to determine which booths will best suit your exhibit needs. The Las Vegas Convention Center has various building characteristics that may affect your booth design and desired location (e.g. low ceiling, floor load capacity, drain availability).

Contact your NACS account manager with any questions.

### **NORTH HALL (Booths 100-3299)**

(Includes Facility Operations and Merchandise, Candy & Snacks areas)

- Special Rigging and Low Ceiling (*Location: Aisles 1600-1700; Booths 1809, 1909, 2009*)
  - Ceiling Height: 24 feet (under Sky Walk structure)
  - Estimated maximum rigging height: 21-22 feet
  - Any booth with rigged signage in the areas marked will be subject to higher rigging fees (estimated minimum \$5,000 in addition to standard rates)

### **CENTRAL HALL (Booths 3300-7499)**

(Includes New Exhibitor Area, Merchandise, Candy & Snacks, Foodservice, Fuel Equipment & Services, and Technology areas)

- Lower Ceiling Height Restriction (*Location: Aisles 3300-4300*)
  - Ceiling Height: 25 feet (Halls C1 and C2)
    - Other areas as marked are lower due to overhead structures. Overhead rigging will not be permitted in areas with 20 ft ceiling heights.
  - Estimated maximum rigging height: 23 feet
  - Due to the lower ceiling in these areas, booths with high truss, theatrical lighting, and higher hanging sign requirements (over 23 feet) are not recommended.
- Floor Drains Unavailable
  - *Aisles 3300-3900 (New Exhibitor Area only)*
  - *Aisles 4400-4500 (Foodservice)*
  - Booths requiring drains in the above listed areas may incur additional fees to have drainage installed.
- Floor Load Capacity (*Location: Aisles 4400-4500*)
  - Uniform Floor Load Limit – 175 lbs. PSF
  - All other areas in both North and Central Halls: Unlimited Floor Load capacity
